#### **Modern Red SchoolHouse signs deal with Alabama schools**

Nashville nonprofit educational training group Modern Red SchoolHouse has signed agreements to offer teacher training to four school districts in Alabama.

Since 1997, Modern Red SchoolHouse has worked with over 100 school districts in 30 states.

Last week, the group contracted with 11 school districts in Arkansas to provide teacher training services beginning next month.

Modern Red SchoolHouse works with school systems to strengthen teaching methods, using standardized measures to gauge progress. The organization was founded 11 years ago by the Hudson Institute and was among the first "break the mold" school improvement models selected by the U.S. Department of Education and the New American Schools Development Corporation to improve public education nationwide.
